

Section B21 Lazy Jacks

B21.1 Lazy Jacks

Lazy Jacks are a system for containing the mainsail when reefing or lowering the sail. The sail falls between the Lazy Jack lines and rests on the boom until such time as the sail can be secured. They are designed for use with fully battened or conventional sails and are rigged with an internal halyard. Lazy Jacks are perfect for single or short handed cruising. A Lazy Jack kit contains every component required for simple easy installation.

B21.2 Boom Cradles

A Boom Cradle is an option for enhancing Lazy Jacks, particularly beneficial on boats with large mainsails that are difficult to handle, and especially if sailed short-handed. It consists of a carrying arm along each side of the boom, forming a broad platform on to which the mainsail will drop, aided by the Lazy Jacks, when lowering or reefing the sail.
